To All Homeowners:

On March 14, 2020, the Horry County Department of Emergency Management announced a State of Emergency in response to COVID-19 (corona virus) pandemic for the entirety of Horry County. Since the announcement there have been multiple cases of infection identified in Horry County. The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has strongly urged the reduction and cancellation of public gatherings of ten or more people.

In an effort to provide a safe work environment for our employees, all homeowners are requested to minimize their visit to the office, especially if you are not feeling well, and we are requesting that you either call us before visiting the office so that we may try to help you this way instead. These restrictions will remain in effect until the Department of Emergency Management indicates that it is once again safe. We will be making any necessary adjustments for meetings scheduled in April, 2020 if necessary. If we find it necessary to change an April Meeting date you will be notified ahead of time.

We are being proactive and following the guidelines of the CDC, which advises meticulous cleaning and disinfection as the most important measures of prevention. We are regularly disinfecting high-touch areas within our office including door handles, reception and conference room chairs and writing instruments to name a few.

We also urge you to monitor the local news for up to date information on this continuously changing event. Lastly we ask you to look after each other and to keep safe.

We apologize for the inconvenience these restrictions may cause, but we feel they are the safest possible response to this event. We hope you will join us in keeping our area a healthy and vibrant community by practicing social distancing as well as other precautionary measures to prevent the spread of the COVID-19.
